### Intonation Rule (I) 腔調

- Yes/No questions usually have a rising tone at the end.
- Example
- **1.** Are you from Tainan?
- 2. Is your English teacher Lily?
- **3.** Can you speak English?
- 4. Can you spell that for me?
- **5.** Do you like your English teacher?

Intonation Rule (II)
Statements and wh-questions end with a falling tone.

- 1. What's your name?
- 2. How do you spell your name?
- **3.** What's your telephone number?
- 4. What's your cell phone number?
- **5.** Where do you work now?
- 6. What department do you work?

7. How many people are there in your family?

### **Intonation Rule (III)**

- Question with or: rising tone on the first choice, the first tone on the last choice
- Would you like coffee? Would you like coffee or tea?
  Would you like coffee, tea, or me?
